FEE STRUCTURE AND INFORMATION

SOMERSET CHRISTIAN SCHOOL (SCS) OFFERS THREE-DAY, FOUR-DAY OR FIVE-DAY PRE-KINDERGARTEN PROGRAMS FORM 8:00 AM TO 11:30 AM FOR CHILDREN WHO ARE FOUR (OR FIVE)YEARS OLD AND POTTY-TRAINED.

FIVE-DAY PROGRAM \$3,100 (OR \$258.34/MO. FOR 12 MONTHS) FOUR-DAY PROGRAM \$2,600 (OR \$216.67/MO. FOR 12 MONTHS) THREE-DAY PROGRAM \$2,100 (OR \$175.00/MO. FOR 12 MONTHS)

ENROLLMENT FEE \$35/CHILD (ONE-TIME FEE)

IF YOUR CHILD NEEDS DAYCARE FOR THE AFTERNOONS, THE RATE IS AN ADDITIONAL \$16.00/DAY.

<u>Tuition:</u> Tuition is due the fifth day of every month, starting July 2024. Monthly payments will be accepted on a twelve-month plan. If payment is not received by the 10th, a \$25 late fee is assessed. We accept check, cash, and credit card. (Credit card users are charged a 3% processing fee.)

<u>Discounts:</u> The first month's tuition is due July 5, 2024. If you choose to pay your full tuition in advance, you will receive a <u>5% discount</u>.

Attendance: If your child is in the three-day program, she/he may come in an extra day to make up for a day they are absent. Arrangements need to be made in advance and will only be permitted if there is availability.

There is no daily rate for Pre-Kindergarten; if you miss a day, your tuition will not be adjusted.

<u>Parent Hours</u>: Pre-K parents are required to complete <u>10 parent hours</u> per school year. These parent hours help provide staffing at fundraising events, which in turn helps to offset the costs that tuition does not cover.


